Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

"And who is my neighbour?" The lawyer's question to Jesus, hostile in its original intent, has echoed down through the ages. It haunts us still. There are disturbing signs that as a society our horizons have narrowed. Individually we are prone to be selfabsorbed, even narcissistic. Collectively we hunt in packs, satisfied and comfortable with our own kind. Few of us would readily admit to being racially or religiously prejudiced. That's partly because prejudice is insidious. It's part of the air we breathe, it permeates the culture in which we swim, it's a parasite in our minds and hearts that we don't recognise as alien to our humanity. Hardly knowing it, we see the "other" with a lack of sympathy, or worse, with fear and loathing. The parable of the Good Samaritan, too long domesticated, still has surprising power to uncover the hidden antipathies that govern our relationships with those who seem strange, foreign or just different. Have we yet understood that all things, in heaven and on earth, have been reconciled when Christ "made peace by his death on the cross"?

Effective Strategies For Hospitality:

Hospitality is not a task we can check off a to-do list.

It's not something that is scheduled.

Hospitality is the attitude we take when we are going about our ordinary routine and we come across a stranger along the roadside who needs our attention. How can we help cultivate an attitude of hospitality?

- Sit in the middle pew so that people who arrive after you have a place ready and waiting.
- When a person sits by you, say hello, shake their hand, and introduce yourself to them.
- Don't wait to be prompted to welcome them.
