## **SOCIAL JUSTICE @ ST KEVIN'S**

During August the second collection will go towards the fight against **Human Trafficking.** 

In the words of Pope Benedict, human trafficking is a "crime against humanity" and a form of slavery which is "unfortunately increasingly widespread, which involves every country, even the most developed, and touches the most vulnerable people in society: women and young girls, children, the disabled, the most poor, whoever comes from situations of familial or social disintegration."

## In 2019, there are 21 million human victims worldwide.

Trafficking happens by coercion, force and deception for sex slavery and labour slavery.

- 8. Did I use the time given for reflection?
- 9. At what times did I 'see more'?
- 10. What would I single out as my most significant need in celebrating the Eucharist?
