Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time

No sooner have we set out on our way through Ordinary Time than we are confronted with the demands of gospel living. Jesus is uncompromising. It is not enough to be outwardly good and religious; our inmost thought and feelings must be thoroughly purified as well. If we wish to be his disciples we must undergo conversion of heart and mind. Gospel living does not allow any dichotomy between the outer self and the inner self. It calls for complete integrity of life. This teaching of Jesus is complemented today by wisdom ancient and new. The author of Ecclesiasticus invites us to choose between life and death, and Paul offers the Corinthians the mysterious wisdom that is now revealed by the Spirit who alone knows the depths of God. Together they offer encouragement. "To behave faithfully is within your power", says Ben Sira. And Paul writes that the wisdom he teaches is "the wisdom that God predestined to be for our glory before the ages began".
