## Gospel Jn 6:51-58

Jesus said to the Jews:

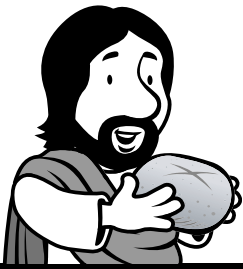
