Students in Years 10 to 12 were asked to address a social justice issue in their community, using the 'See, Judge, Act' method to apply the principles of Catholic social teaching to their project. Proposals included a research paper, a video submission, a project impact report and a funding proposal. Three grants, one each of \$10,000, \$5,000 and \$2,500, were available to the winning projects.
