wherever I am my servant will be there too.

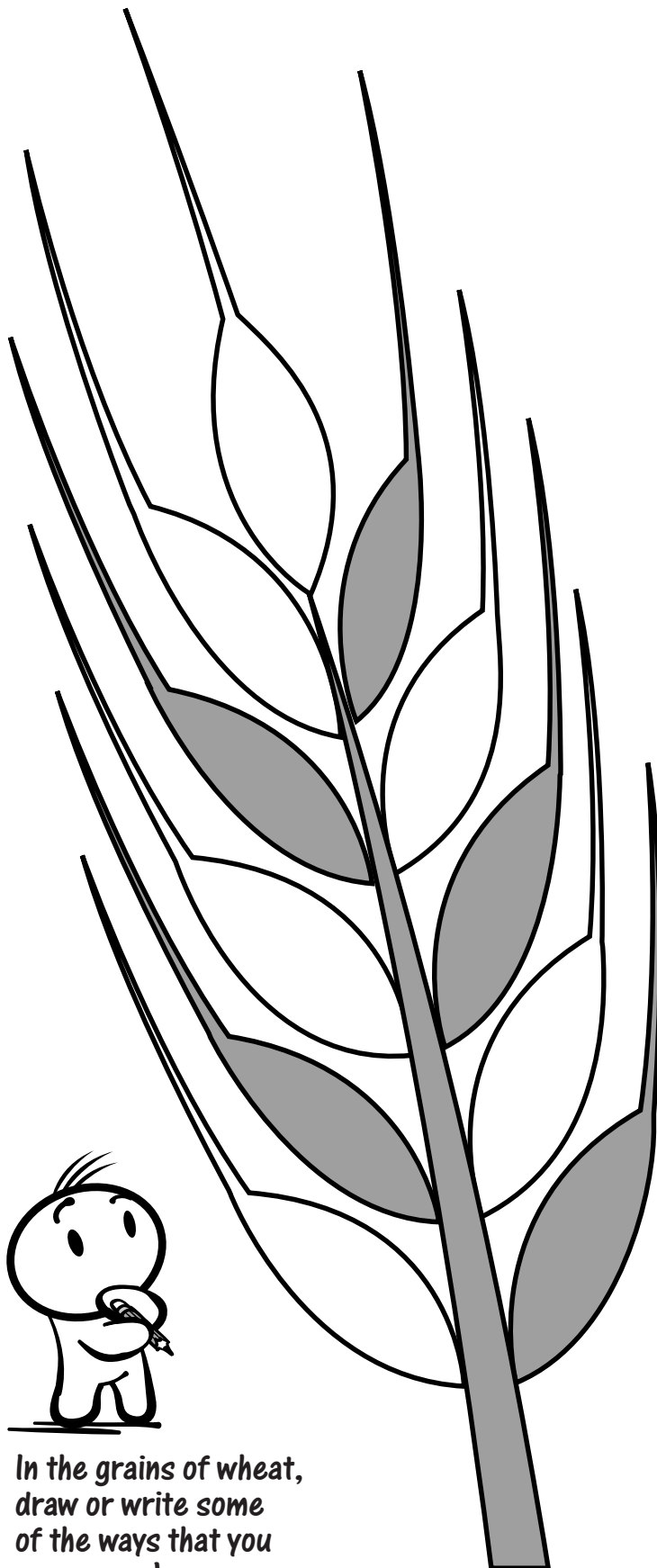
