Reconciliation Service:

As I announced a while ago a single **Reconciliation/Penitential Service** will be held for St Greg's and St Kevin's – this will be held **at St Kevin's on Thursday Evening 16th December at 7:30 pm.** I will be most willing to stay on after the main service to provide individual absolution, the service itself will not include an explicit segment for the second-rite individual absolution. You can also of course meet with me before/after any Mass at which I am presiding or make other arrangements to meet. I know this is different – please come along and try it out. Alternatively, there are two other Second Rite Reconciliation services in the near vicinity: St Clement of Rome Bulleen 7:00 pm 15th December; and Ss Peter & Paul's Doncaster East 7:30 pm 16th December.

There are many reasons I have made this choice of one Penitential Service for the two parishes I shepherd. The primary reason has two main facets: I am time poor and the Liturgy Group (namely Izabella Fantin) at St Kevin's stepped forward and offered to take on essentially all the arrangements: so I accepted their offer; and other services in the area had already drawn on the services of many available priests so arranging assistance for our service was problematic. It seems best to me to hold our service as an extended formation of conscience with me being available after the service and at other times for the First Rite of Reconciliation. I pray this works out well and look forward to having you join me.
