## From the PP's Desk...

Thank you, thank you to those progressing with Working with Children Checks and Code-of-Conduct signing: We are above about 75% compliance (up from under 50% a few weeks ago). Please don't stop now—100% compliance is ultimately the only acceptable level.

I spoke last week about leadership coaching. Along with Margaret, Tiziana, Alfred and Carmel I had the first leadership coaching session with Ron Huntley. We were all pleased with the way Ron started us on a journey of thinking and discerning, and hopefully planning for action.
